

RECOGNITION FOR 4-H MEMBERS 4-H LEADERS & ACHIEVERS MEDAL

Criteria for selection:

- 1. The 4-H Service Medal will be presented each year to one (1) outstanding 4-H Junior, Intermediate, or Senior 4-H Member. Grade requirements are: grades 3th 8th at the time of application.
- 2. The member must attend at least 50% of his/her club meetings.
- 3. Must have been in 4-H for at least one year.
- 4. The 4-H Leaders & Achievers Medal will be presented to the most deserving 4-H member without regard to gender.
- 5. The 4-H member must submit a 4-H Record book in the year he or she is to be considered for the 4-H Leaders & Achievers Medal
- 6. The 4-H'er will showcase a leadership project and or series of leadership examples that support leadership on the project, club, and / or county level where the youth served in primary role.
- 7. Must have participated in various 4-H activities and community service experiences.
- 8. A member may receive the 4-H Leaders & Achievers Medal only one time.

Judaina process:

- A check of award eligibility and required application materials.
- Judging of the awards application.
- An interview with a panel of judges.
- Review of 4-H record book and achievements.
